



Extension installation with the help of 'Component Manager'.

Having purchased any extension on Magento Marketplace, you need to install it. Go to the 'Extension Menu'. Navigate to 'System' > 'Web Setup Wizard'.



From the 3 blocks of options, which you have at your disposal, choose the 'Component Manager'.



Here, you will see the extensions already installed on your website, new updates for them, and new extensions, which you can install. Click on the 'Install' link, below the 'New Purchases' label.


Step 1: Readiness Check



Step 2: Create Backup



If you choose the latter, you will receive a confirmation screen, that the backup has been successfully created, and then you can click the **'Next'** button to proceed.


You will now see the extension you want to install. Click **'Install'** to continue.



Step 3: Component Install

⚠ We will take your store offline to protect shoppers during the duration of the install activity.

We're ready to install mageworkshop/module-shopping-cart-notifications to 1.0.0.



Once the installation has been completed, you will receive a confirmation and will be able to go back, by clicking **'Back to Setup Tool'**.

Installation of the extension from the archive

Magento 2 install extension using command line (Recommended)

The Detailed Product Review extension can be installed or updated by following these steps.

***Note:** Before you install any extension, we recommend you to create a backup of your Magento store.

Step 1: Download/purchase the extension.

Step 2: Extract the archive content in a temporary directory.

Important! If you do not need some modules then they can be deleted. For example, ShoppingCartNotifications, ReCaptcha, AdminResponse, Akismet, Seo, SocialSharing, SocialSharing and Voting are additional modules and can be deleted if you do not need them.

Step 3: Disable the cache under 'System' >> 'Cache Management'.

Step 4 (for Recaptcha module only): This step is optional. If you plan to use the ReCaptcha module from MageWorkshop then execute the following command in the Magento root directory:

```
composer require "google/recaptcha"
```

Step 5: Switch Magento 2 to the maintenance mode:

```
php bin/magento maintenance:enable
```

Step 6: If you're updating the MageWorkshop modules then all old module files must be removed in order not to keep the just files in the system. Please, remove the folder '<Magento 2 root directory>/app/code/MageWorkshop/'.

```
rm -rf app/code/MageWorkshop/*
```

Step 7: Upload or copy the archive content to the directory '<Magento 2 root directory>/app/code' so that you now see the folder '<Magento 2 root directory>/app/code/MageWorkshop/'.

Step 8: Enter the following commands to process the installation or upgrade:

```
php bin/magento cache:clean
```

```
php bin/magento cache:flush
```

```
rm -rf var/generation/* var/di/* generated/* var/view_preprocessed/*
```

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

After running these commands check current Magento running mode with the following command:

```
php bin/magento deploy:mode:show
```

Possible values are: 'developer', 'default' or 'production'. If you're running Magento in the 'default' mode then also run:

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

If you're running Magento in the 'production' mode then also run:

```
php bin/magento deploy:mode:set production
```

* If the message " Manual static content deployment is not required in "default" and "developer" modes. ..." appears, this step can be skipped

Step 9: Run the reindex process:

```
php bin/magento indexer:reindex mageworkshop_detailedreview_eav  
mageworkshop_detailedreview_flat
```

Step 10: Disable the maintenance mode:

```
php bin/magento maintenance:disable
```


Step 11: Done. In Admin Panel after opening 'Stores' >> 'Configuration' >> 'Mageworkshop' >> the module must be on the list. You can also run the following command to ensure that DetailedReview module was installed:

```
php bin/magento module:status | grep MageWorkshop
```



```

```

```
